When it comes to a 401(k), many folks tend to set it and forget it. Yet many easy tweaks can help ensure a fatter nest egg. Here's what you should

IN YOUR 20s

Jumpstart your way to wealth by...

● **Investing anything:** Not prepared to contribute the maximum to your 401(k)? That's okay. What's most important is that you invest, even if it's just 2% or 3%. The early start helps you reap the rewards of compound interest—when interest earns interest—faster, says financial planner Greg Womack, author of *Wisdom & Wealth*. In fact, a 10-year jumpstart can more than double your bottom line!

IN YOUR 30s

Stay on the road to riches by...

● **Following the "Rule of 120."** Unsure what percentage of your portfolio should be in stocks? Simply subtract your age from 120, recommends financial advisor Alan Haft, author of *You Can Never Be Too Rich*. "At this stage, having anywhere from 80% to 90% in stocks lets you take advantage of higher yields while giving you time to ride out any market slides," he says. As for the rest, put it "in safer investments, like bonds or fixed-interest accounts."

● **Weighing the Roth 401(k).** Some employers have been featuring this option since 2006—and if your company is one of them, you may want to take advantage. Why? Unlike traditional 401(k)s, your money is taxed before going into the account. That means you won't have to pay taxes to withdraw funds come retirement time—when you're likely to be in a higher tax bracket!

Tip! Aim to invest at least the minimum required to get your employer's matching contribution—it really is free money!

● **Maxing out—without a pinch.** Sign up for auto-escalation, which raises your contribution annually by a percentage you choose. Pick a 1% increase and you'll barely notice the difference in your paycheck.
